 - 1. Heb. 10:25 (LB) "Let us not neglect our church meetings, as some people do, but encourage and warn each other, especially now that the day of his coming back again is drawing near."
- B. Tithing and Giving
 - 1. Mal. 3:10 (NAS) "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, so that there may be food in My house, and test Me now in this," says the LORD of hosts, "if I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you a blessing until it overflows."
 - 2. Prov. 3:9-10 (NAS) ⁹Honor the LORD from your wealth And from the first of all your produce; ¹⁰So your barns will be filled with plenty And your vats will overflow with new wine.
 - 3. John 14:15 (NAS) "If you love Me, you will keep My commandments."
 - 4. Prov. 11:24-25 (NAS) ²⁴There is one who scatters, and yet increases all the more, and there is one who withholds what is justly due, and yet it results only in want. ²⁵The generous man will be prosperous, and he who waters will himself be watered.
- C. Doing good works
 - 1. Eph. 2:10 (NAS) For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them.
 - 2. Gal. 5:13c (NAS) Through love serve one another.
 - 3. I Peter 4:10a (NAS) As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another.
- D. Being right about the Bible all the time.
 - 1. John 13:35 (NLT) "By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."
