- A. Eph. 3:20 (NAS) *“Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us.”*
- B. When they heard the words of the prophet Haggai, whom the LORD their God had sent, the people feared the LORD. <sup>12</sup>Then Haggai, the LORD’s messenger, gave the people this message from the LORD: “I am with you, says the LORD!” <sup>13</sup>So the LORD sparked the enthusiasm of Zerubbabel son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the enthusiasm of Jeshua son of Jehozadak, the high priest, and the enthusiasm of the whole remnant of God’s people. They began rebuilding the house of their God, the LORD of Heaven’s Armies.*

Haggai 2:6-9 (NLT) *“For this is what the LORD of Heaven’s Armies says: In just a little while I will again shake the heavens and the earth, the oceans and the dry land. <sup>6</sup>I will shake all the nations, and the treasures of all the nations will be brought to this Temple. I will fill this place with glory, says the LORD of Heaven’s Armies. <sup>7</sup>The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, says the LORD of Heaven’s Armies. <sup>8</sup>The future glory of this Temple will be greater than its past glory, says the LORD of Heaven’s Armies. And in this place I will bring peace. I, the LORD of Heaven’s Armies, have spoken!”*
